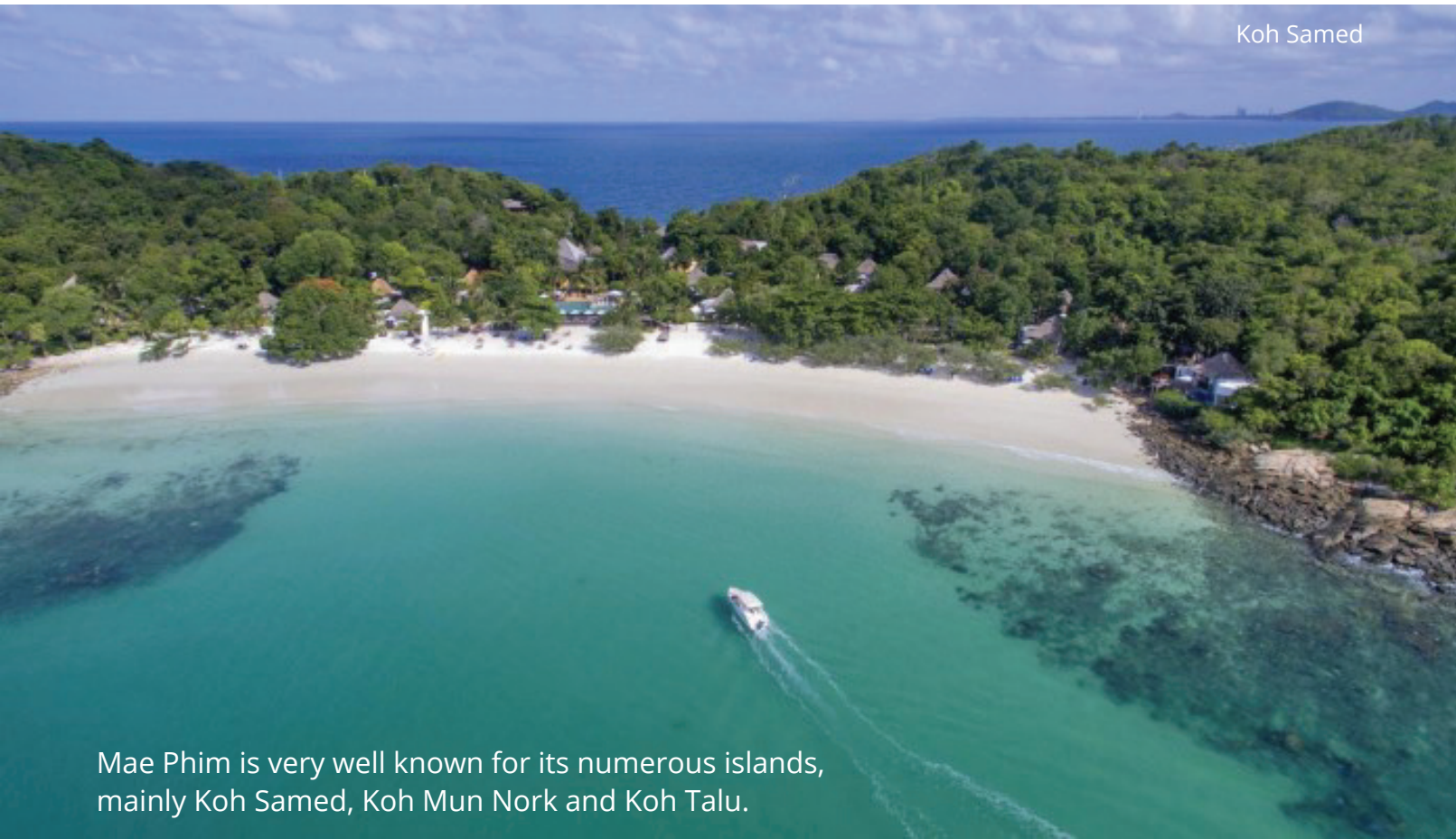


Island-Hopping Adventure
